- August 25, 2007- made qualifying attempt at the Milwaukee Mile. Qualified 26th for the race.
- August 26, 2007- Competed in the Governor's Cup 200 at the Milwaukee Mile. Had engine problems. Was asked to finish race in the #1 car of Dominick Casola. Finished in 27th position.
- October 13, 2007- made qualifying attempt at the Toledo Speedway. Did not qualify. Was used as a back up driver in the #5 car for Bobby Gerhart.
- October 14, 2007- Competed in the Hantz Group 200 at Toledo Speedway. Started last and finished the race in the #16th spot.
- December 14, 15, & 16, 2007- Traveled to Daytona International Speedway for the ARCA testing session.
- February 8th & 9th, 2008-Traveled to Daytona International Speedway for the ARCA 200 at Daytona, did not qualify.
- April 13th 2008-Traveled to Salem, Indiana for the Kentuckiana Ford Dealers 200 by Federated Auto Parts. Qualified in the 19th spot, finished 28th, due to engine failure.
- May 3rd, 4th, 2008-Traveled to Rockingham, NC for the Carolina 500. Qualified 33rd, after standing on time in first round of qualifying. Finished the race in the 20th position.
- June 7th 2008-Traveled to Long Pond, Pa for the Pocono 200. Qualified in the 20th Position, finished the race in 25th spot, after falling victim to a late race incident while running in the top 10.
- August 2nd 2008-Traveled to Long Pond, Pa for the Pennsylvania 200 at Pocono International raceway. Qualified 24th, and finished 38th, after suffering engine failure.
- September 13, 2008- Traveled to Salem, Indiana for the Eddie Gilstrap Motors 200 at Salem Speedway. Qualified 21st and finished 15th.
- September 28 2008-Traveled to Milville, NJ for the Loud Energy Drink 150 at the New Jersey Motorsports Park, Thunderbolt Raceway (road course). Qualified 25th, finished 21st **Race ended early due to rain. **

- Competed in the beginner class and won every feature event, 18 wins out of 18 races, in a 10+ car field
- Competed in the Novice class at the age of 6 during my second season of competitive racing, average competition was 7-8 years old
- Competed in the Novice class for a full year at West end Fairgrounds Speedway and Blue Mountain Speedway at 7 years old
- During this time, won 40 Feature races; 20 at Blue Mountain Speedway and 20 at West end Fairgrounds Speedway
- At West end Fairgrounds Speedway at 8 years of age, Competed in the "Rookie" class; won 12 out of 20 races in a 10+ car field
- Competed at Blue Mountain Speedway in a 5hp light class at age 8-9
- Competed in the 5hp stock class at 9 years of age; won 8 out of 20 feature events in a 10+ car field.
- Competed in the 5hp light class at Blue Mountain Speedway at the age of 9; won every feature event, 20 wins out of 20 races in a 13+ car field
- Competed in the 5hp Modified class at the age of 10 on a limited schedule of 10 races; won 5 out of 10 feature events in a 10+-car field.
